MFAA State Championship and Nenameseck 300 Championship Shoot Information Sheet

Format – This is a dual tournament. First is the Massachusetts Field Archery Association (MFAA) State Championship, open to those who are members of the MFAA and have shot a minimum of three MFAA shoots this season. The second tournament is the Nenameseck 300 Championship tournament, open to all shooters with no membership or minimum shoot requirements.

All participants will be entered in the Nenameseck 300 Championship tournament and medals will be awarded for the first three places in each class/style category. Only MFAA members with three shoots this season will be entered in the MFAA State Championship – at no additional charge. State medals will be awarded to the first three places in each class/style category to those who qualify. Because those entered in the State championship are also entered in the Club championship, there is a real opportunity for shooters to be awarded medals for both tournaments

This competition will consist of a single 300 round consisting of 12 ends of 5 arrows each. The NFAA indoor single spot or five-spot target will be used with scoring of 5-4-3-2-1-M (3,2,1 available only on the single spot target.) There will be two ends of practice before the competition begins. No other practice will be allowed at the site. There will be a strictly-enforced time limit of four minutes/end. Bottom shooters shoot first, followed by top shooters. Archers will switch targets (top for bottom and vice versa) after six ends. There is NO break during the competition.

NAA Members – NAA members may become members of the MFAA for a \$10 fee. NAA members who are also MFAA members and have shot three MFAA shoots during the season are eligible for the MFAA state championship. All NAA members are automatically eligible for the Nenameseck 300 championship as there are no membership requirements for that tournament.

Attire – The NAA rules of attire will NOT be in effect.

Food/Drink – The clubhouse kitchen will be open serving food and beverages for a nominal fee.

Directions – *MassPike, exit 8, left after tolls onto route 32 north. Take third right onto Old Warren Rd. Follow to end and take a left onto route 67 east. Take second left onto Ware Rd. Follow to entrance of the club. Use 190 Bacon Rd, Palmer for GPS. NOTE: Bacon Rd is closed from the route 32 side.*
