8. **NFAA Directors Report:** The NFAA Director went over some key items in the NFAA Annual Meeting that was held in February 2013.

**Added rule to formally adopt minimum number of faces passed and amended to say 35 and 36 yard fans now require a minimum of two 50 cm faces mounted side by side.*

** Expand Junior (C.Y,YA) styles to add BHFS passed*

**X-ring Scores as "6" for Pro Division only-passed. Pro Archers must track Xs speeratley at all NFAA sanctioned outdoor rounds- includes States and Sectionals. NFAA score cardes have been updated to included an X count column. Non Pro Divisions may use Xs (counted as 5) as tie breakers at the direction of the Tournament Director.*

**Conform Senior sub-divisions to USAA,ASA and IBO age minimums-passed. As of June 1st "senior" is now 50+, "Silver Senior" is now 60+ and "Master Senio" is now 70+ and all Adult styles now allowed in all Senior Divisions.*
