7. **Tournament:** State Championship awards have all been handed out. Discussion took place on looking into some changes in the clothing award for points collected over the year. Possibly adding a new soft shell jacket to replace the sweat shirts and a wicking style polo shirt. Ruby said she will speak with the supplier and get back to Greg on pricing. Ruby will get the list for points awarded over to Greg Gioiosi to review and give to Pat Tuttle to post,

once the Granby shoot scores are available. Pat Tuttle stated that the form which will be posted online has also changed to help facilitate the order process.

8. **NFAA Directors Report:** The Nationals in Deerington WA had a decent turn out with somewhere around 300 shooter. They had great weather and the courses were challenging.

The counsel planning meeting is to be held in October. There the dates will be firmed up for 2015. The Annual meeting will likely be in April., it will not be held in Vegas to help save money. The location has not been determined yet. If anyone has any suggestions or rule changes they would like to bring up, please let Paul Lewkowicz know.

N.E. Championship being held August 31 and Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> at Lunenburg with Steak BBQ Saturday after the Animal Round. 9-8 we will be the Last outdoor MFAA shoot at Grandy. There is a Non MFAA 900 round fun shoot at Lunenburg on 9/15 and a Fita warm up on 9/29. **Old Business:** Charters and range inspections need to be addressed. Charters need to be done and renewal fees paid every year. Range Inspections are good for 2 years. A suggestion was made to see if instead of sending information to the club Secretary, if they could go to the Archery Chairman to ensure the information goes to someone that is involved with Archery. To officially change who the information goes to, a letter or email needs to be sent to Nations.

**New Business:** To expand on awards: There was a discussion on whether shooters would be allowed more than one item for points accrued during the year, since this has been brought up in the past. It was agreed that a shooter would have to have over 250 points to be allowed more than one item, but not to exceed the points awarded.

The next meeting to be held on Oct. 6<sup>th</sup> is to pick shoots for next year. Your club must be present and charters up to date to pick shoots. Nenamesek will be hosting the state indoor and outdoor shoots next year. A discussion took place on whether a meal would be nessecary. The past few pick shoot meeting were over by lunch time. It was decided that a meal would not be needed.
