7. **Tournament:** Shooter Awards was discussed, Clothing vs Gift Certificates. Jeff Grieman decided he was to do one or the other and we do Gift Cards we need to choose between Lancaster Archery or Local Shops, not both. It was mentioned that some shooters have not been in the MFAA as long and may want to do the clothing. A vote was cast to do one or the other: 6 votes for clothes and 5 for gift cards. Ruby has offered to help with the order, Greg Gioiosi also offered. Pat Tuttle to put a form on the MFAA website for people to put their orders in. Please have your orders in by Oct. 31st 2012. The points are posted and anyone with 40-69 pints can order a hat, 70-99 Points is Golf Shirt, 100-199 points Windbreaker or vest, 200+ points Jacket or Heavy lined Hooded Sweatshirt. New Business: There has been an influx of younger 10 yard shooter who say they are interested in competing in the MFAA shoots this year. Woburn Joad has grown to 112 and Teepee at 70 and a question was brought up as to how we plan to handle the growth. It was mentioned that not all the shooter will want to travel and the influx would mainly be east where the growth has been. It was asked if the MFAA would allow the use of another club for the overflow.

The Decision was made that there will be a 1pm line for children shooting at 10 yards for Woburn,
Teepee, Rivderside and Lunenburg since these are the clubs that will be most impacted by this influx.
This said we ask that the 20 yard shooter be more diligent in getting to the shoots at these clubs, so
they will be done in time. If there is a date that a club finds there will be too many children shooting
to handle, an agreement can be made with another club to handle the overflow.
